Greetings!! We are requesting your help in identifying students to attend the **Rural Health Careers Camp** to be held **June 13, 2014** on the campus of Frontier Community College and Fairfield Memorial Hospital. **There is no cost for attending the camp**. We will provide transportation to and from the Camp. Students will be picked up at their <u>High School Parking lots at 7:30am</u>

We are looking for incoming freshman, sophomore students. Approximately 50 students total from various high schools in the area will be chosen for this exciting opportunity.

The goals of this Camp are three-fold:

- 1. Provide students from rural areas with current information about the broad array of careers available in the health professions, especially in Southern Illinois.
- 2. Inspire students from rural areas with a passion for science, math, and helping others to pursue health-related careers.
- 3. Introduce students to the college and hospital campus.

To achieve these goals, students attending the Camp will:

- Obtain hands-on opportunities in various labs and classroom environments to learn more about what health professionals do and how they are trained.
- Receive information about educational and academic requirements for the various health professions.
- Meet practicing health professionals and current college students who are pursuing health careers.

Frequently Asked Questions:

How many students will be selected?

Approximately fifty students will be chosen to attend the camp.

How are students chosen for the Camp?

Students are chosen for the camp based on academic standing, year in school and interest in Health Careers.

Why do students need to identify their high school guidance counselor and an additional school reference?

To assure that students are in good academic standing, high school guidance counselors and school references will be contacted.

Who should attend?

Incoming freshman and sophomore who have expressed interest in a health professions career requiring training at the community college level (e.g., radiology technician, LPN) or have demonstrated an aptitude and interest in science and math courses or those students who are looking at a Bachelors or higher education in healthcare. (e.g., nurse, social worker, dentist, pharmacist, medical doctor, physical therapist, mental health therapist, public health official, etc.)

How do I apply?
