The Hamilton County Ambulance Service is committed to providing superior emergency care and transportation to Hamilton County, Illinois, and the surrounding area. The HCAS is sponsoring scholarships in the areas of EMT and Paramedic with the goal to reach people with interest and provide a professional opportunity for people in our community. The following are the guidelines for each scholarship based on the amount and quality of applications received.

- \$250 to begin EMT Paramedic or EMT program at Rend Lake College.
- Full tuition to be reimbursed after the completion of the EMT program AND 32 hours/week of working for the HCAS for 1 year.
- Full tuition to be reimbursed after the completion of the EMT Paramedic program AND 32 hours of working for the HCAS for 2 years.
- The scholarship is available to homeschooled and public school students.
- The HCAS scholarship committee reserves the right to alter the payout of the final scholarship monies based on the completion of the program or service given to the Ambulance Service.
