The District is responsible for promoting the conservation of soil, water, wildlife, woodland and other natural resources of the county. An elected five member Board of Directors governs the activities of the District.

The Hamilton County Soil and Water Conservation District is offering a scholarship to be awarded to a graduating senior of Hamilton County High School. *To be considered; the applicant must meet the following guidelines; failure to do so will result in the application being dismissed.*

The application *must* be typed with resume and transcript attached.

The student *must* have a major relative to the field of natural resources.

The student *must* have a grade point average of 3.0 or above.

The winner will not immediately receive the scholarship funds, a Certificate of Entitlement will be forwarded to the college in which the student is enrolled after the beginning of the fall semester.
