Mary M. Winemiller Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating Senior from Hamilton County Unit #10 Senior High School with an interest in the medical field. There are several concentrations of the medical field that involve direct and indirect contributions to create innovative technologies which allow for growth in the medical community. These include, but are not limited to; physicians, nurses, psychologists, pharmacists, chemists, botanists, physiologists, researchers, etc. Students who wish to pursue a degree in something unrelated to the medical field (business, financing, teaching, etc.), but still wish to further their education in one of the aforementioned fields are encouraged to apply. The selected student will demonstrate superb work ethic and determination.

The following is the minimum required to be considered as an applicant:

- Minimum 500 word personal essay explaining why you want to work in your chosen speciality, and what makes *you* the best for said career path
- Community Service hours
- Official Transcript
- List of extracurricular activities
- Minimum of three Letters of Recommendation
- Minimum of 10 hours of shadowing from a healthcare professional.
- EFC/FAFSA print off

Students who will be considered strong applicants will also consider the following:

- Community service hours outside those required for mandatory coursework (Civics)
- Strong Letters of Recommendation from varying sources (don't have three teachers write you letters of rec, try to have a teacher, an employer, and a coach, for example)
- More than three Letters of Recommendation
- Exceed the minimum shadowing hours
- Exceed minimum word count on essay
- Strong GPA (>4.5)
- Any type of paid work experience
- Providing listing of any special training/certifications (lifeguard, pharmacy technician, basic cardiac life support, etc.)
- Strong written communication skills

TIPS:

- Personal Essay must be typed (it would be a good idea to have several people proofread it)
- Community service hours can be a photocopy of your Civics hours
- Extracurricular activities typed, but not in the same document as personal essay

- Letters of Recommendation are to be typed and sealed in an envelope. Students are not to see their letters of recommendation. Envelopes that appear to have been tampered with and/or opened and resealed will not be accepted.
- Guidance office will provide the form needed for Shadowing a Health Professional
- Once completed, *all* documents must be turned into the Guidance Office.
- The FAFSA/EFC documentation provides us with information about the financial needs of the student

This scholarship will not be accessible for use by the selected student until proof of enrollment in courses has been received from the Registrar's office of the college of attendance. The selected student will only have a full calendar year (April 4th, 2018) to provide proof of enrollment into a community college, or university. If the aforementioned date has passed, the scholarship will default to another applicant from the class of 2017. Good luck applicants!
