Multiple sclerosis shouldn't stand in the way of an education. This is why the National MS Society's scholarship program exists — to help highly qualified students who have been diagnosed with MS or who have a parent with MS achieve their dreams of going to college.

Who can apply?

High school seniors who have MS or who have a parent with MS; or high school (or GED) graduates of any age who have MS or who have a parent with MS.

Applicants must also:

- ✓ Plan to attend an accredited post-secondary school for the first time.
- ✓ Enroll in at least six credit hours per semester in coursework leading to a degree, license, or certificate.
- ✓ Plan to enroll in an undergraduate course of study at an accredited two or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school in the United States.
- ✓ Be a citizen or legal resident of the United States.

Allocations:

Most awards are between \$1,000 and \$3,000, although a limited number of awards may exceed this amount.

Deadlines:

- ✓ Applications may be submitted from October 1, 2012 through January 15, 2013.
- ✓ Scholars receive notification of awards in mid April 2013.

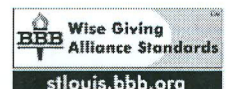
