JIM AND JOHN BURNS SCHOLARSHIP

CRITERIA

The Jim and John Burns Scholarship shall be awarded annually to a graduating senior of Hamilton County Senior High School who will attend a four-year college. The scholarship shall be paid directly to the institution which the recipient will attend. Seniors may complete an application available from the guidance office. Selection will be made by the scholarship committee.

The Scholarship will be awarded based on the following criteria:

1. Financial need;
2. Excellence in academic achievement; and
3. Excellence in extracurricular activities.
