By an act of the Illinois General Assembly, the first Monday in March is recognized as Casmir Pulaski Day, in honor of the Polish nobleman and soldier. He won fame for his role with the Continental Army in the Revolutionary War in America. Pulaski sailed to America in 1777 to offer his services to General George Washington. He was Washington's aid-de-camp at the Battle of Brandywine in September 1777. At Washington's urging, Congress made Pulaski a brigadier general. He was an expert cavalryman who organized a group of soldiers that became known as Pulaski's Legion. Pulaski's group performed well in their fighting in the South. His soldiers participated in the siege of Savannah, where Pulaski was wounded on Oct. 9, 1779. He died two days later.
