- 7. Be a liaison between the bus drivers and the Director of Transportation as needed.
- 8. Maintain and submit any records and forms as required by the school district.
- 9. Correct any problems discovered during bus driver vehicle safety checks as soon as possible and as warranted.
- 10. Develop and implement a mechanical preventative maintenance program for all Unit #10 vehicles and maintain service records on all Unit #10 owned vehicles.
- 11. Oversee the care and maintenance of the bus repair facility, equipment and District's tools in an orderly and efficient manner.
- 12. Supply basic set of mechanic tools to perform job duties.
- 13. Be available to attend Board meetings as requested to discuss issues related to vehicle maintenance.
