A. Annual Meeting

B. STEM Lab Update

 Amanda reported that the old computer lab has been renovated and converted into the new STEM Lab. The room has been painted, carpeted, and has new tables and chairs. Among the innovations included in the lab are: 3D printers, Z-Space Program, laser cutter, video-editing equipment, GoPro, water distiller, Cricut, and a bio-freezer.

A. STEM Lab Tour

1) Amanda provided a tour of the new lab, explained the technology and software programs available for students and teachers, and presented an airplane video in which paper planes were created by the students using the GoPro.

B. Maurice and Shelly Reed STEM Lab Donation
